Parent Night Schedule Change:

Please note that the 11/12 parent night with Duncan Laird and the college counseling program for the parents of seniors that were scheduled for November 8th has been rescheduled to Thursday, December 1st. The parents of seniors will meet with Amy Grieger and David Perry from 6 - 7 PM in the Common Room followed by a meeting with the parents of juniors and seniors with school counselor, Duncan Laird from 7:15 to 8:15.
