Climate Connections is an introductory earth science and geography class. Much of the course is focused on water because it is essential to life on earth and plays such a major role in shaping the landscape and how people live around the world. In addition, students study the cause of the seasons, phases of the moon, map reading and cartography skills. Following this, students study weather and the atmosphere, leading to an exploration of the effect of human development on global climate. Major projects include research papers and a mapping project. Numerous field trips are an integral part of the course.
