Spanish V is an elective course traditionally taken by students their final year at The Academy. The course content varies from year to year, as the curriculum is largely shaped by the interest of the students in the class. This year, for example, students were interested in Surrealism and conducted research projects on varying aspects of the movement and taught a lesson to the class. Students have read young adult novels in Spanish, rewritten a board game in Spanish and written original dramas. The primary emphasis of Spanish V is verbal communication skills, in order to assure students leave with confidence in their speaking and listening abilities.
