## Update from Head of School:

Nora shared the following updates:

- <u>Boarding program</u> -- hopes to open Fall 2019, with home in Shelburne Falls being considered. Small group of lenders. Working online to get 12 total students, 9-12 grade, mix of international and domestic boarders. Staffing: House Parent, Respite Parent, Residential Life Director. Pax will only bring students who stay with families, so that will continue.
  - Discussion of flex options? Five day boarding is an option.
  - Are there models for this kind of ancillary boarding? Yes
- <u>Capital Campaign</u> -- will support boarding and upgrades to the main campus facilities
- <u>6th grade</u> -- there are two and they are just doing 7th grade, but programs will fork next year.
- <u>Senior Projects</u> are underway under supervision of Dr. Fagan. New this year: each Senior will have an outside mentor. List of Senior projects is available for members of the community to review if they are interested in helping in this manner.
- <u>Grinnell Sessions</u> are mini-courses to be held in January right after break. They welcome parents to teach them -- anything from 1-3 days. Contact Mr. Schatz.
- <u>Seeking</u> intro to Spanish teacher for spring to 6th and 7th. Three blocks a week (55 mins each), and Ultimate Frisbee coach
