II. Finances

A. Professional Development support

- 1. Dr Bloomfield reported that this year PD financial support was not requested due to new staffing, but would be appreciated next year.
- 2. Suggestions for new funding included a flat of drinking glasses, coffee pumper pot and sports related tents and/or banner to put on the tents at tournaments, plus portable score boards.
 - a. Agreed to two low cost portable score boards (manual, not digital!)
 - b. Carol will research cost of "academy" imprinted tents.
 Discussion of pros and cons of painting on one or hanging a banner off of one. Agreed it cannot look hokey. Dr. B reported the school is looking to put wooden score boards at both fields.
 Trish, Carol, and Dr. B will be the subcommittee to decide on this over the summer.
 - c. All approved purchase of pumper pots, if house pots were not functional. School requested to buy more drinking glasses and let us know if school needed funds to purchase. Many of the brown water glasses are scattered around the school (we found at least a dozen at the Work Bee).
 - d. Support was also given for purchase of coffee for staff, as part of our campaign to "show the love."

 - a. Current "point people" for each event (that were present at meeting) agreed to continue with prospective positions.
 - b. Diane and Trish offered to help Penny with drama bake sale coordination.

 - d. New cochairs are needed for next year. Phoebe explained that the majority of the responsibility was in facilitating meetings and liaison with school and staff. Some present agreed to consider it for a while and get back to the current cochairs, who will both have seniors next year and need to help them apply to college.
 - e. Marguerite and Melanie agreed to take on the "random acts of staff appreciation" function others welcome!
 - f. NEW: Phoebe asked if there was support for having a new task that could be described as: "host a social gathering of some kind for Academy parents" all agreed that having this a more explicit goal was a good idea, since forging connections between our families is part of our mission. Decided that we would ask for volunteers each quarter at the meeting
 - g. NEW: Marguerite and Melanie offered to be a gardening committee to weed /mulch/transplant more often during the year. Others welcomed a chance to join them if they get warning!
