This course examines how English language and styles of composition spread throughout the British Empire to become some of the tools with which postcolonial peoples crafted reflections of their culture, daily lives, and social and political realities. Though the titles in this course were originally published in English, many use a lexicon rich in local languages and dialects. The goal of this course is that students are not only able to understand something of the cultures represented in the selected novels, short stories, and plays, but to articulate their thoughts and feelings regarding imperial rule, colonialism, and post-colonialism.
