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Foundations in Art 9

Foundations in Art seeks to build essential skills and knowledge for creating and analyzing art and visual media. In 9th Grade Foundations, students will approach art as a way to communicate, ask questions, and engage with others. Students will work with drawing, painting, digital video, text-based artwork, block printing, relief sculpture, and other mediums. Through a series of projects, students will explore concepts including form, perspectival space, realism, and materiality. Students will also explore concepts including mimesis, semiotics, propaganda, and critique. Throughout the course, we will be looking at a wide range of work from contemporary and historical artists and makers; we will use these examples to help us figure out what it is *we* want to say to the world, and how we want to say it through visual means.
