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Biology

Biology is the scientific study of life. This course introduces fundamental concepts of biology and teaches basic skills that are useful in exploring living things at different levels of complexity, from the microscopic world of molecules and cells to the grand scale of ecosystems and the Earth's biosphere. Because human beings are living things, this course seeks to equip students with a better understanding of how they themselves are connected to the unity and diversity of all living things through the form and function of their own bodies, minds, and behaviors. In the lab portion of this course, students will learn how to collaborate using hands-on inquiry, creativity, and careful data collection and analysis in small groups.
