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Environmental Science

Environmental Science is the study of the interactions between living things and the abiotic natural world. The course explores how living things, and humans in particular, interact with and shape the atmosphere, hydrosphere, geosphere, and biosphere of our planet. We focus both on current events and on how the biosphere has evolved symbiotically over deep geological time. We take advantage, as much as possible, of the natural resources surrounding us here on campus and elsewhere through frequent field work and occasional off-campus field trips. The course also has a collaborative long-term project component that typically focuses on sustainable development.
