The FRTA is a public transportation service and is subject to different regulations. It is subsidized by the U.S. Department of Transportation and the Franklin Regional Transportation Authority.

Families may purchase tickets directly from FRTA or pay cash when boarding the bus. Students may ride the FRTA anytime for \$1.25 to Shelburne Falls or Greenfield.

Starting on August 7, 2017, FRTA introduced their new Go-Card program which allows unlimited travel on FRTA's fixed routes for 31 consecutive days for \$30.00.

You may purchase tickets or a Go-Card at the FRTA office located at the John W. Olver Transit Center, 12 Olive Street, Greenfield, MA, 01301 between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm, Monday through Friday.



## The Academy at Charlemont Bus Route Rates, 2017–2018

School year bus passes are available for all routes. Families may sign up on Registration Day or throughout the year. Annual bus passes are invoiced equally over 9 months (September to May). Please contact the office for additional information. Rates may also be subject to additional fuel charges.

The Academy operates two bus routes that we contract. Students without year long passes may ride these routes by signing a designated clipboard as they get on the bus. These trips will be tracked and families will be invoiced. These routes do not take cash.

If a student has a pass for either Route #1 or Route #2, s/he may ride the other Academy bus at no additional charge. Although there is usually additional seating on each route, we are unable to guarantee a seat for students without bus passes.
