The Academy at Charlemont Bus Route Rates, 2019–2020

School year bus passes are available for all routes. Families may sign up on Registration Day by bringing in the form below. Annual bus passes are invoiced equally over ten (10) months (September to June). Please contact the office for additional information. Rates may also be subject to additional fuel charges.

The Academy operates two bus routes that we contract. Students without year long passes may ride these routes by signing a designated clipboard as they get on the bus. These trips will be tracked and families will be invoiced. These routes do not take cash.

If a student has a pass for either Route #1 or Route #2, s/he may ride the other Academy bus at no additional charge. Although there is usually additional seating on each route, we are unable to guarantee a seat for students without bus passes.

Current Rates (Subject to Change): These rates reflect the full price and are not prorated.
