Part-time School Nurse

The Academy at Charlemont is seeking a part-time registered nurse who enjoys working with adolescents. This role involves 8-16 hours per week with The Academy community. Primary responsibilities include:

- Working with school administrators to develop and implement health and safety policies
- Administering and managing medical care and medication in accordance with Massachusetts Department of Public Health regulations
- Providing in person and remote medical consultation
- Planning and/or providing in-service education for school personnel regarding assisting students with medication, bloodborne pathogens, first aid and emergency care procedures, and other appropriate health issues,
- Serving as an intermediary between the school, home, private physician, and health and social agencies regarding the health status of students and their needs.
- Interpreting medical evaluations to students, parents, and school personnel and providing an understanding of implications for the educational performance of students.

Qualifications: A candidate must possess or be able to obtain Massachusetts DESE certification as a school nurse, have experience as a Registered Nurse in Massachusetts in a school or community health setting, have a genuine appreciation of adolescents, and the ability to work as part of a team.
