The consulting responsibilities may include, but are not limited to, meeting with Deans and other faculty regarding counseling sessions, providing professional development to our faculty around socio-emotional support, or best practices in working with students who present with specific learning or behavioral challenges. Additionally, this individual may be asked to hold group sessions with students in both classroom settings (such as Health classes) and in response to social-emotional issues that may be affecting a larger cohort of students. This position requires some flexibility of schedule, excellent ability to provide follow-up communications to families of counseled students, and ongoing communication with the Dean of Students.
